Our Belief

Insuring the Children is an organization dedicated 03

entitled to a life free of abuse and neglect.



Every child is entitled to a life free of abuse and neglect.

Physical Abuse

The intentional use of physical force that can result in physical injury. Examples include hitting, kicking, shaking, burning or other signs of force against a child.

Sexual Abuse

Pressuring or forcing a child to engage in sexual acts. It includes behaviors such as fondling, penetration and exposing a child to other sexual activities.

Emotional Abuse

Behaviors that harm a child's self-worth or emotional well-being. Examples include name-calling, shaming, rejecting, withholding love and threatening.

Neglect

The failure to meet a child's basic needs, including housing, food, clothing, education, access to medical care and having feelings validated and appropriately responded to.

Insuring the Children funds direct service and prevention programs of the various agencies addressing child abuse and neglect in our community. We pre-screen and approve all agencies receiving your support. Grants are only awarded to nonprofit, tax-exempt organizations.

History

Since January 1998, Insuring the Children has awarded more than \$2.5 million in grants. Eight organizations received grants in 2025. Grants fund specific programs that align with our mission and make the biggest impact on reducing child abuse and neglect cases. Due to low operating expenses, 95% of your donations go directly to local social agencies like these.

GLAD House provides a safe and therapeutic community to empower families to break the cycle of addiction and delivers comprehensive care to children and families, building resilience and paving the way for brighter futures.



Child Advocacy Centers provide a welcoming facility where children feel safe and coordinate teams of compassionate representatives to guide children toward healing. The CACWC has served more than 3,500 victims since opening their doors in 2008.
